

- Furniture from Storeroom is available to all. For clients currently with a support agency, ask your key worker to refer you to Storeroom. For clients currently between jobs, ask your Job Centre Plus to refer you to Storeroom.
- Storeroom helps people across our island community who do not have the means to furnish their homes.
- Unfortunately as the stock is constantly changing, Storeroom cannot guarantee availability of any particular items.
- Please bear in mind all Storeroom stock is donated and may not always be in perfect condition.

In October 2008 the Storeroom project was one of the winners of the Community Action Awards, sponsored by the County Press, the Isle of Wight Rural Community Council (RCC) and the Isle of Wight Charitable Trust.

All monies raised are used to support the Storeroom project and vulnerable people in our Island community.

- IW Green Gym - a conservation group - mix keeping fit with helping wildlife!

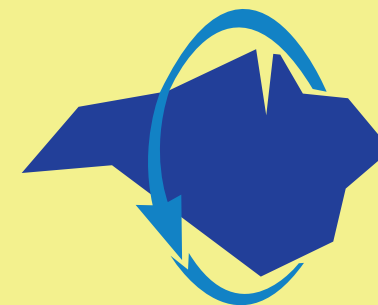

The Storeroom project is a proactive charitable organisation priding itself on its strong sense of community spirit

Storeroom collects items of reusable furniture (compliant with Fire Safety in the case of soft furnishings) then offers it at low cost to the Island community who are not able to furnish their own homes.

Furniture donated by Island residents may otherwise have been taken to the landfill site, so this also minimises the impact on the environment. Storeroom offers Island residents this recycling opportunity to really help their community and the environment.



Open to everyone

Our warehouse and shop are both open to the general public and to referred clients from various support agencies. The referred clients are offered a further discount on furniture.

If you are on low income, or cannot resist a bargain, visit Storeroom. We may have just what you need. All purchases help keep this valuable Island project running. Generally, referred clients can make savings of 30-50% on purchases made.



The process is simple!

If you have any usable furniture that would suit our project, please call Storeroom. All items need to be in reasonable condition and compliant to Fire Safety regulations.

Local Business Partnerships

Storeroom was previously awarded funding from DEFRA (Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs) and is actively seeking to forge links with other local businesses with a view toward reducing landfill by recycling useable items that otherwise might be discarded.



We collect most household items including the following: -

We are sorry, but due to legislation we cannot accept any gas appliances or free standing electric cookers.

We also do not collect clothing.
