Our warehouse and shop are both open to the general public and to referred clients from various support agencies. The referred clients are offered a further discount on furniture. Generally, referred clients can make savings of 30-50% on purchases made.

We collect most household items including the following: -

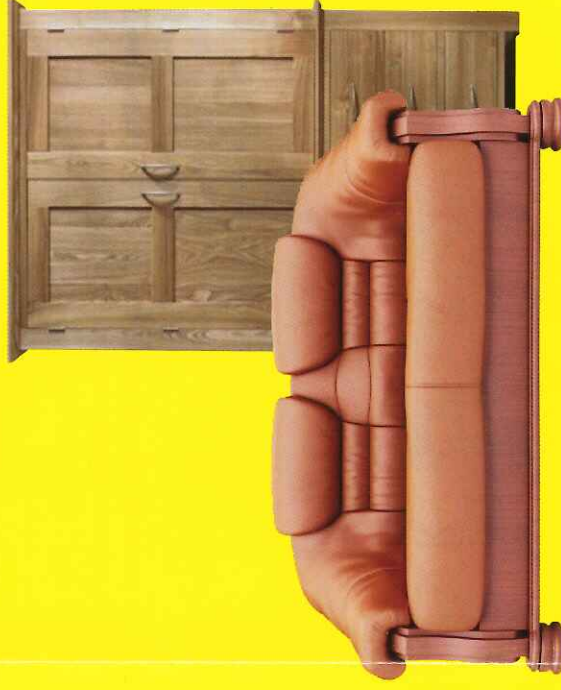
